### Ornamental Shrubs

#### The speaker for October will be Tony Russell

Tony Russell is a leading authority on trees and shrubs and for many years was the Head Forester of Westonbirt.

He is also garden consultant to the National Trust and is a garden writer and editor of the annual publication, Great Gardens to Visit.

Tony will be drawing on his extensive experience to talk about and illustrate the wonderful variety of ornamental shrubs that we can grow in our gardens.

## Euonymus alatus compactus.



**A wonderful small shrub with stunning autumn colour.**

Following this month's topic of ornamental shrubs, October's featured plant of the month is *Euonymus alatus compactus*. It's a compact, deciduous shrub. Its ultimate height after 20 years is 2.5 metres, so is perfect for a small garden providing a burst of intense colour in autumn when its leaves turn a fiery red.

It grows in any soil and is happy in either sun or partial shade
