## Wild Flowers and Castles of Transylvania: The speaker for October will be Razvan Chisu.

Razvan is a garden designer, editor of the Saxifrage Magazine and writes for various other gardening magazines. Razvan grew up in Transylvania in a town surrounded by vast woodlands and species-

rich wildlife meadows. After gaining a BSC and MSc in Horticulture he went on to work in the Herbarium of the Botanical Garden in Cluj in Romania and then to create gardens in Transylvania and the UK.

#### Rudbekia

Rudbekia are a great late summer flower to have in the garden as they keep flowering well into October, usually until the first frost giving wonderful autumn colour.

There are so many wonderful varieties to choose from. They look wonderful combined with Echinacea and grasses like Stipa and Calmagnostis which are also at their best at this time. Some are perennials and are usually yellow like Rudbekia Goldsturm and some are biennials like Rudbekia Hirta Cappuccino and are in a variety of shades of orange, dark red or brown.



I have these growing in well-drained soil in France and they reappear every year. Now is the time to order seeds for sowing next spring for wonderful autumn colour next year.
